Campers or staff members with serious ailments/injuries are transported to the local urgent care facility or hospital by camp staff or 911.

Primary Responsibilities

- Caring for sick or injured campers on a daily basis
- Medication Management
- Responding to emergencies
- Communicating with camper parents, Executive Director, consulting physician, staff medic and Camp Director.
- Maintaining State and ACA regulations pertaining to youth camp health care and medication dispensation, as well as required reports, daily health logs and other required paperwork.
- Performing routine health checks on campers and staff

- Running and managing the health care facility.
